Corrina Bonshek & Collaborators bring artists and audiences together from different cultural backgrounds to celebrate our shared connection to the spectacular, biodiverse ecosystems that sustain us. ABOUT TOWER DIVAS

Tower Divas is created by award-winning composer Corrina Bonshek in collaboration with three awe-inspiring and deeply earthed artists: Yolngu songstress Gambirra Illume (NSW), Maori sonic weaver Whaia (QLD), and Korean-born vocalist and improviser Sunny Kim (VIC).

It features three powerful goddess-like singers whose voices call across space and time, and act as a force for healing that unifies and brings people together. Each singer has a different cultural and musical background, which is reflected in their vocal stylings.

Their powerful voices float over a swirling soundscape of transformed underwater sounds, insects, wind, stone and electronics that evoke the elemental building blocks of life.

Dressed in stunning totem-inspired headdresses designed by Whaia, each singer is elevated on a 1m high plinth with a parachute skirt that moves continuously throughout the show. Costume and headdresses transform the singers into Goddess-like figures.

Surrender to the mesmeric frequencies of these three powerful voices as they call out across space and time.

PERFORMANCE SPECIFICS

Duration: Festival mode: 30-40 minutes with the option of two or three shows per night. Can be performed during the day, at dusk or after dark.

Touring party: 6 pax

Tech Details:

We can design the speaker/stage layout for any outdoor or indoor space.

The following specs are for the three singers in L shape layout in a 40m x 25m rectangular performance zone which suits an audience of 1100 pax.

Sound

- 4 speaker line array with 2 independent subs
- Mixing desk with 24 in/out
- iPad controller
- 3 x Wireless mic headset + transmitters- Sennheiser JAG IMX6A “Countryman” or equivalent for vocalists.
- Wired vocal mic for rehearsal only

Staging

- 3 x 1m high white circular plinth for each singer to stand on. We put pool noodles on the edge (sliced lengthways and covered in white tape) to soften plinth edges to ensure good shape for the skirts even with wind.
- 24 Sandbags for skirts

Lighting

- 16 x 9x15W (or similar) IP65 RGBW Par Cans (RGBWAU preferred) with clamps and safety cable
- 3 x 3m F34 290mm box truss
- 3 x 800mm steel base plates
- Fusion wash fixtures to suit site.
- 10 x 5m DMX, 10 x 10m DMX, 10 x 20m DMX
- Power: 4 x 10A 240v circuits (3 for lighting, 1 for lighting ops). 10 x 5m 10A 240v piggyback extensions. 10 x 10m 10A 240v piggyback extensions. 10 x 20m 10A 240v piggyback extensions.
- Additional lighting to gradually illuminate nearby architectural OR natural feature As part of the show.

Creative team will provide

- 1 x Audio interface, ableton controller & Apple laptop with ableton for sound design(Corrina).
- 1 x Apple laptop and DMX interface for lighting design (Blake).

Sample schedule for tech/dress run day

Time	What
3 hours	Bump-in of audio equipment, staging and lighting if outdoors
90mins	Sound check soundscape / speaker routing (Corrina & Aaron & Festival team)
45mins	Sound check vocals with effects (15mins per vocalist)
15mins	Group soundcheck
90mins	Evening. Stop/ Start run (with lighting cues etc) and full run.

BIOGRAPHIES

Residing on Awabakal & Worimi Country, **Gambirra Illume** A.K.A. *Mamma G* is a Yolŋu woman from the Gumatj Clan of Northeast Arnhem Land, N.T. She has over 30 years as a multidisciplinary artist; Gambirra is a performer, exhibiting visual artist, producer, facilitator, cultural arts educator, and clinical mental health coach.

She is a key Ceremonial vocalist of *Dream Drone*, First Nation's vocalist for Richard Petkovic's *Sydney World Music Chamber Orchestra*, a member of the *ILLUME Girls*, and leader of the 12-piece band '*Gambirra MOB*'. Gambirra has composed and produced music works for Catapult Dance Company, NAISDA Dance Company, Legal Aid NSW, Bowerbird Collective and of late Australian Geographic: '*Our Country*' Immersive.

WHAIA (Aotearoa / NZ) is a Sonic Weaver, Vocalist, Multi-instrumentalist, Designer/Stylist, Creative Producer. Whaia works with Taonga Puoro/Traditional First Nations Instruments and Singing Crystal Bowls creating her own unique cradle of embedded healing phonics. She activates an ancient primordial voice that calls beyond the veil of this earthly world.

A Ngati Kahugnunu woman raised in the outback of Western Australia, the land and her Aboriginal grandmother shaping her story from age 6. Touring with the band 'Bunna Lawrie & The Whaledreamers' in 2012 for 4 years, she has sung the whale songlines across Australia.

Her debut album **WHAIA & WATER** is 1st part of her 'Sacred Sonic Sessions' honouring the waters of the planet and our first home of water, the womb. With a depth of ochre in her skin and mana in her bones, she's a true warrior woman with a soft yet powerful delivery, entwining one's heart, body and spirit.

Sunny Kim is a Korean-born vocalist, improviser, composer and educator based in Melbourne, Australia. Drawing from her life journey as a global nomad - Seoul, Kuala Lumpur, Bangkok, Denver, Boston, New York and now Melbourne - Sunny's artistic practice seeks to find meaningful connections to people, culture and place through a dedication to self-discovery, deep listening and collaboration. A two-time winner of Jazz People's Magazine's Reader's Poll Awards in the Best Vocalist category (2012-13) and the recipient of the LIG Artist grant (2011), Sunny Kim has released five albums as a leader, three of which have been nominated for the Korean Music Awards in the Best Jazz Record category. Sunny has worked with hundreds of musicians, dancers, poets and visual artists and has performed internationally. Invited by the Australian Music Centre, Sunny delivered the Peggy Glanville-Hicks Address in 2020. <https://www.sunnykimmusic.com/>

With 20 years of composing across concert halls, and festivals to her name, composer and director **Corrina Bonshek** (PhD Western Sydney University) has a deep passion for crafting music-led experiences that provoke wonder at the beauty of nature, the cosmos and each other.
